- 2 David Shepherd made a submission about the subject matter of the proceedings (submission 2135).
- The Shepherds are not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991.
- 4 The Shepherds are directly affected by an effect of the subject of the appeal that:
 - 4.1 adversely affects the environment; and
 - does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.
- 5 The Shepherds are interested in all of the proceeding.
- 6 The Shepherds are interested in the following particular issues:
 - 6.1 The Appellant's appeal of the zoning of the Appellant's property as Wakatipu Basin Rural Amenity Zoning.
 - 6.2 The Appellant's appeal of the minimum lot size provisions within the Wakatipu Basin Lifestyle Precinct.
