- 1 Andrew Fairfax and I & P Macauley (**Fairfax & Others**) wish to be a party pursuant to section 274 of the RMA to the following proceedings:

Arthurs Point Protection Society v Queenstown Lakes District Council (ENV-2018-CHC-000067) being an appeal against decisions of Queenstown Lakes District Council on the proposed Queenstown Lakes District Plan (**PDP**).

- 2 Fairfax & Others made submissions about the subject matter of the proceedings.
- 3 Fairfax & Others are not a trade competitors for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the RMA.
- 4 Fairfax & Others are interested in all of the proceedings.
- 5 Without derogating from the generality of the above, Fairfax & Others are interested in the following particular issues:
 - (a) Amendments sought to Chapter 36 (Noise) pertaining to the application of NZS6807 to measure noise from helicopters and the use of the averaging methodology;
 - (b) The relief sought to retain the Leq limit of defining noise limits in Chapter 36.
- 6 Fairfax & Others oppose the relief sought because the relief:
 - (a) Is not effects-based planning which is envisaged under the RMA, and is contrary to the intent of the introduced informal airport activity rules.
 - (b) Ignores significant evidence presented in the PDP which supported the application of NZS 6807 to measure helicopter noise and the appropriateness of the averaging method.
- 7 Fairfax & Others are willing to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
