**DECISION OF THE DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE**

**APPLICATION**

- [1] An application was filed by Yael Martinez Llamas with the Queenstown Lakes District Council for a Manager's Certificate. It was considered in accordance with s.191(2) and s.222 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
- [2] The Licensing Inspector has been unable to engage with the Applicant as no emails or calls have been returned. Enquiries with the Applicant's employer at the time indicate he is no longer employed at the premises.
- [3] Enquiries with Immigration NZ indicate the Applicant has left the country.

**THE HEARING**

- [4] The Applicant made no appearance at the hearing.

## **DECISION**

- [5] The Applicant has not engaged with the Inspector since his application was made. It is also apparent the Applicant is no longer working within the hospitality industry or otherwise where there is a requirement to hold a manager's certificate.
- [6] Without the benefit of hearing from the Applicant we can make no finding regarding the criteria we are obliged to consider in s.222 of the Act.
- [7] Accordingly, the Committee rules pursuant to s.221(1) of the Act, that the above application for a new Managers Certificate is denied.
