- Tucker Beach Residents Society Incorporated ("TBRSI") wishes to be a party under section 274 of the Resource Management Act 1991 ("Act") to the following proceedings:
  - An appeal by the Middleton Family Trust ("Appellant") against a decision of the Queenstown Lakes District Council ("Council") on its Proposed District Plan ("Plan").
- 2. TBRSI made a further submission to the Appellant's submission on the Plan.
- 3. TBRSI is not a trade competitor for the purpose of Section 308C or 308CA of the Act.
- TBRSI is interested in all of the proceedings.
- 5. TBRSI is interested in the following particular issues:
  - a. The relief sought by the Appellant being the rezoning of its land as Tucker Beach Residential Precinct.
- 6. TBRSI opposes the relief sought by the Appellant because
  - a. TBRSI supports the Council's rejection of the relief sought by the Appellant in its submission.
  - b. TBRSI agrees with the finding of the Hearings Panel that the rezoning sought by the Appellant was not appropriate as:
    - Insufficient information was provided in respect of effects on the transport network;
    - ii. Insufficient information was provided in respect of servicing the development anticipated by the zoning;
    - iii. The rezoning would lead to unacceptable landscape, visual and urban design effects; and
    - iv. The rezoning would be contrary to the higher order provisions of the Plan and would not give effect to the Otago Regional Policy Statement.
- 7. TBRSI agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
