#### 5. The relief sought is opposed because:

The decision of the Respondent is supported in full. To this end, in the context of the grounds of appeal:

- The TCEP should not be extended to include land between Searle Lane and Church Street.
- Searle Lane is an appropriate boundary to define the extent of the TCEP. Land to the east of Searle Lane contains office and visitor accommodation on its upper floor levels which would be adversely affected by the more lenient noise limits applicable to the TCEP.
- Extension of the TCEP to the east of Searle Lane will give rise to additional adverse effects.
- The Appellant provided no expert evidence in support of its submission at the first instance hearing, in particular expert noise evidence.
