EIGHTH PROCEDURAL MINUTE UPDATING ARRANGEMENTS FOR UPPER CLUTHA MAPPING HEARINGS

Introduction

- 1. The purpose of this Minute is to update our seventh procedural minute dated 25 January 2017 and to confirm arrangements for the Upper Clutha mapping hearings commencing on 15 May at the Lake Hawea Community Centre.
- It is intended to read alongside the formal Notice of Hearing which has now been issued by the Council, along with the Section 42A Report and accompanying evidence in accordance with the first step of the prehearing timetable set out at paragraph 3 of our seventh minute.
- 3. Since our seventh Minute, we have received a number of applications and have issued five minutes directing variations to the arrangements set out in that Minute:
 - (1) A Minute responding to an application on behalf of M Beresford issued 10 February 2017:
 - (2) A Minute responding to an application by QLDC issued on 6 March 2017;
 - (3) A Minute responding to an application on behalf of Glendhu Bay Trustees issued on 9 March 2017;
 - (4) A Minute responding to an application by Berne Sugrue issued on 23 March 2017;
 - (5) A Minute responding to an application by QLDC issued on 24 March 2017.

- 4. We have also received a number of applications that have been dealt with more informally. Specifically a number of submitters and further submitters have been added to the Hearing Schedule as follows:
 - (1) Messrs Fountain (Submitter 33) and Suddaby (Submitter 448) have been inserted at 3:30 pm on 23 May 2017, their request to be heard having inadvertently not been actioned previously;
 - (2) Mr Darryll Rogers (Further Submitter 1138) has been inserted at 2:40pm on 25 May 2017. Mr Rogers advised that he had failed to appreciate the need to confirm his previous request to be heard and his late request was able to be accommodated;
 - (3) Mr John May (Further Submitter 1094) has been inserted at 10am on 14 June. Mr May's representatives advised that they likewise had inadvertently failed to confirm Mr May's request to be heard in respect of his further submission and due to the rescheduling of another submitter (noted below), there was a gap in the Hearing Schedule that could be reallocated to Mr May;
 - (4) Tui Advisers (Further Submitter 1053) and Noel Williams (Further Submitter 1149) have been inserted into the Hearing Timetable at 4:50pm and 5:00pm respectively on 13 June. Again, the failure to provide confirmation of their wish to be heard was a result of inadvertence, and these further submitters could be allocated two 10 minute slots at the end of the hearing day;
 - (5) Jim Ledgerwood (Submitter 507) has been inserted into the Hearing Timetable on 23May. Mr Ledgerwood inadvertently failed previously to confirm his wish to be heard;
 - (6) Ros and Dennis Hughes (Further Submitter 1011) has been inserted into the Hearing Schedule on 7 June. The failure to provide confirmation of their wish to be heard appears to have been a consequence of their further submission having been miscoded.
- 5. Other material changes to the Hearing Timetable are as follows:
 - (1) Queenstown Airport Corporation (Further Submitter 1340) has been shifted within the timetable, now to be heard commencing 3:50pm on 1 June and continuing with a half day slot on 2 June, to accommodate a conflict with the Environment Court Hearing on the Otago Regional Policy Statement;

- (2) The one day hearing slot previously occupied by Varina Pty Limited on 24 May has been reallocated to Hawthenden Limited with the former being shifted to the hearing slot on 30 May previously allocated to Hawthenden Limited to accommodate the unavailability of a key Hawthenden Limited expert witness for the later hearing slots. Consequent on the Varina shift, Sneaky Curlew Pty Ltd has also been shifted to 30 May as the relief sought by the latter overlaps with that of Varina Pty Ltd;
- (3) Ms Heather Pennycook (Submitter 585) has been shifted to the 3:50pm slot on 7 June in order that she might be heard in conjunction with Royal Forest and Bird Protection Society Inc;
- (4) M Beresford has been shifted to the hearing slot commencing 12:20pm on 14 June for the reasons set out in the Minute referred to above:
- (5) Peninsula Bay Joint Venture has been deleted from the hearing Schedule, consequent of the Council's resolution (on 16 March 2017) to withdraw the land the subject of Plan Change 51 from the Proposed District Plan.
- 6. These are unlikely to be the last changes to the Hearing Schedule. We have just been advised of a conflict one counsel (acting for a number of parties) has arising from an Environment Court fixture in the week of 22 May.

Pre-Hearing Timetable

- 7. Our Memorandum of 25 January 2017 directed the following steps following release of the Notice of Hearing and Section 42A Reports on 21 March 2017:
 - (1) Date for lodging submitter evidence 4 April 2017;
 - (2) Date for lodgement of rebuttal evidence 28 April 2017;
 - (3) Hearing Panel site visits week of 8 May 2017.
- 8. Those directions have since been varied in the following respects:
 - (1) Provision has been made for the landscape and planning evidence for Glendhu Bay Trustees Limited to lodged on or before 1pm on 11 April 2017 accompanied by supplementary briefs of evidence of any witnesses whose evidence requires amendment consequential on the final form of that evidence (refer our 9 March Minute for the details);

- (2) Any rebuttal evidence on the evidence of Glendhu Bay Trustees Limited referred to in the previous point, may be filed on or before 1pm on 5 May 2017 (refer our 9 March Minute for the details);
- (3) The Council may file updated outputs from its dwelling capacity model together with evidential commentary thereon on or before 1pm on 28 April 2017 (refer our 6 March Minute for the details);
- (4) Any rebuttal evidence on the Council's dwelling capacity model outputs and/or Council witness commentary thereon may be filed on or before 1pm on 8 May 2017 (refer our 6 March Minute for the details);
- (5) The planning evidence for Bernie Sugrue may be filed on or before 1pm on 14 April (refer our 23 March 2017 Minute for the details);
- (6) Rebuttal evidence for Council may be filed on or before 1pm on 5 May (refer our 24 March 2017 Minute for the details).
- For the avoidance of doubt, save as has been the subject of previous direction, and summarised above, the Panel's directions of 25 January 2017 for circulation of evidence remain in place.
- 10. That means, in summary, that unless the subject of separate direction:
 - (1) Evidence in Chief must be lodged on or before 24 April;
 - (2) Rebuttal evidence must be lodged on or before noon on 28 April.
- 11. We should, however, add a note of clarification. The Hearing Administrator has been asked to confirm the evidential requirements for further submitters. Further submitters are still submitters. Accordingly, their evidence in chief should be filed on or before 4 April. The content of that evidence will, however, reflect the extent to which the further submitter is able to anticipate the case brought on the primary submission that they support or oppose. If the primary submission in question is quite detailed (some submissions have included, for instance, large amounts of technical detail and/or a section 32 analysis), there may be quite a lot a further submitter might usefully contribute by way of evidence. Other submissions are relatively sparse in terms of the detail of what is proposed, and why, in which case, there may be little or nothing a further submitter could usefully contribute by way of evidence in chief.

12. Further submitters have the ability to file rebuttal evidence within the time specified for that purpose (generally 28 April, but subject to the exceptions noted above).

13. Such rebuttal evidence should cover the matters that the further submitter was not able to

anticipate would be raised by the primary submitter. The Hearing Panel expects further

submitters to take a realistic and common sense view when applying these considerations.

It does not intend to undertake a forensic analysis on a point by point basis as to what

further submitters might or might not have been able to reasonably foresee the primary

submitter would say in evidence.

14. Lastly, we note the Chair's Minute dated 17 March 2017 confirming that the previous

direction (prior to the commencement of hearings on the text of the Proposed District Plan

dated 25 January 2016) that expert witnesses may only present one brief of evidence per

topic did not apply to the mapping hearings and stating a preference that legal submissions

and evidence address the changes requested in each discrete geographical area

separately.
