Rules for Residential Visitor Accommodation

in the Rural Zone



The activity is registered with QLDC prior to commencement.



The total nights do not exceed a cumulative total of 120 nights per year from the date of initial registration.



Up to date records of the **Residential Visitor** Accommodation activity are kept in a form that can be

made available for inspection by QLDC at 24-hours' notice. The records need to include the date and duration of guest stays and the number of quests staying per night.



You must provide at least one mobility parking space¹ if your property will be accommodating 6 quests or more.



If you would like to operate outside of these rules, you will need to apply for resource consent. Please refer to our website for more information.

¹ Mobility parking spaces should be:

- > on a level, well maintained, surface with good drainage
- > clearly signposted
- > located on the same site as the Residential Visitor Accommodation
- > be as close as possible to the Residential Visitor Accommodation entrance
- > be at least 3.6 metres in width x 5 metres deep
