- 1. Leslie and Judith Nelson ("**Nelsons**") wish to be a party under section 274 of the Resource Management Act 1991 ("**Act**") to the following proceedings:
  - a. An appeal by Skipp Williamson ("Appellant") against a decision of the Queenstown Lakes District Council ("Council") on its Proposed District Plan ("Plan").
- 2. The Nelsons made a submission on the subject matter of the Appellant's appeal.
- 3. The Nelsons are not trade competitors for the purpose of Section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991 ("**Act**").
- 4. The Nelsons are interested in all of the proceedings.
- 5. The Nelsons are interested in the following particular issues:
  - a. The zoning of the Appellant's land and other land within Landscape Character Unit ("LCU") 6 (Wharehuanui Hills) as Wakatipu Basin Rural Amenity Zone ("WBRAZ").
- 6. The Nelsons support the relief sought by the Appellant because
  - a. The Nelsons support the Appellant's view that land within LCU 6 is capable of absorbing additional development.
  - b. To rezone such land as WBRAZ is not in accordance with sound planning principles and is an inefficient use of resources.
  - c. The decision to rezone the land as WBRAZ was not in accordance with the expert evidence submitted in respect of the rezoning of the land which recommended that a zoning of Wakatipu Basin Lifestyle Precinct was appropriate.
- 7. The Nelsons agree to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
