

0001 Marion Read Principal

This is a joint statement made by Dr Marion Read of Read Landscapes (on behalf of QLDC) and Mr Nick Geddes of Clark Fortune McDonald and Associates (on behalf of the Jardine Family Trust, Remarkables Station Ltd & Homestead Bay Trustees Ltd).

On the 29th of August 2017 Mr Geddes and I walked the boundary of the ONL of Jacks Point Hill on the Jardine land. We mapped this boundary by hand using large scale aerial photographs on which it was possible to identify the landscape features we were able to see on the ground. I drew the boundary in the location on which we agreed. These aerials were then scanned and sent to Mr Geddes office where they were digitised and mapped. This map is attached to this statement.

Unexpectedly we found that the boundary transgressed the proposed boundary of the amended OSR activity area in a number of locations. These boundaries have been 'tweaked' so that this no longer occurs. I understand that because of the inclusion of areas between the notified OSR boundary and the corrected ONL boundary into the OSR that area remains approximately the same as the amended area. The caption on the plan identifying the area of the OSR has not been updated to reflect the amended submission.
