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## The further submission of Ladies Mile Pet Lodge Limited is as follows:

- [1] This is a further submission from Ladies Mile Pet Lodge Limited ('Pet Lodge') in response to certain submissions made on the Te Pūtahi Ladies Mile Variation to the Proposed District Plan ('Variation').
- [2] Details of submissions and whether they are supported or opposed along with the reasons for opposition is contained in <u>Schedule 1</u> below.
- [3] The Pet Lodge further submits that the land is not suitable for development, as the roading and related infrastructure will not support the scale and intensity of development proposed in the Variation and the area proposed is not suitable for the form and scale of development.
- [4] The Pet Lodge further submits that certain submissions are not ON the Variation and there is no jurisdiction to include land in the Variation and for it to be rezoned.
- [5] The Pet Lodge has significant concerns regarding the disconnect between the transport network in the Variation and Waka Kotahi – New Zealand Transport Agency plans for State Highway 6.
- [6] The submitter wishes to be heard in support of its original and this further submission.
- [7] The submitter is a person having an interest greater than the public interest as they are a landowner directly affected by the Variation.
