- 1 Friends of Wakatipu Gardens and Reserves and Associated Residents (**FOWGR**) filed an appeal (ENV-2018-CHC-098) on 19 June 2018 on Stage 1 of the Queenstown Lakes Proposed District Plan (**PDP**).
