 - (a) Cardrona Alpine Resort Limited v Queenstown Lakes District Council [ENV-2018-CHC-117]
- 2. The Applicant is a person who made a submission about the subject matter of the proceeding (OS 315) and has an interest in the proceedings greater than the public generally. - (d) Noise generated from informal airports is intermittent and transitory. Therefore higher noise levels are appropriate.
