### 1. Name of party giving notice:

Scope Resources Limited ("SRL").

# 2. The relevant proceedings are:

An appeal against a decision of the Respondent on Chapter 18A General Industrial and Service Zone and Related Variations to Chapters 25, 27, 29 and 36 of Stage 3 of the Queenstown Lakes Proposed District Plan ("PDP"). The decision appealed against is the refusal to rezone the Appellant's land to industrial.

# 3. The party giving notice is:

SRL is a person that made a submission in the previous proceedings on the same matter and in respect of such submission is a trade competitor for the purposes of s308B.

- **4.** SRL is directly affected by an effect of the rezoning the subject of the appeal that—
  - (a) adversely affects the environment; and
  - (b) does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.
- **5.** SRL is interested in all of the proceedings.
- **6.** SRL is interested in the following particular issues that are raised in the notice of appeal:
  - The operation of the landfill at Victoria Flats ("Landfill"), and the future "life" of the Landfill and its ongoing operational requirements.
  - The adverse reverse sensitivity effects arising as a result of an industrial zoning on the operation of the Landfill.
  - The effectiveness of measures and conditions to manage the potential for adverse reverse sensitivity effects on the operation of the Landfill.
  - The presence and nature of odour associated with the operation of the Landfill.

- **7.** SRL opposes the relief sought and supports the decision of the Respondent to refuse to rezone the land industrial.
- **8.** SRL agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
