Location: Park Street, Queenstown.



Features: The gardens have a rotunda, power (charges apply) and limited public toilets. There is limited event parking available in the gardens' car park - parking time restrictions apply. There are other paid car parks around town.



Event suitability: This reserve is only suitable for non-commercial, recreation and cultural events. It is highly visited by residents and visitors, therefore events are limited and must demonstrate benefit to the community or district. Events will require a tree protection plan.



Price: Prices vary based on booking type. Please scan to see our pricing document or enquire about booking this space.

Planning an activity or event on one of our beautiful reserves?

Some events may require an **event permit, resource consent,** or a **licence to occupy,** depending on the nature and duration of your activity. We'll assess what's needed once we receive your request.

Here are a few key things to keep in mind (list not exhaustive):

- Manufified sound after 8:00pm requires Resource Consent.
- Events (including setup and pack-down) that run for 6 days or more, or 40 days in a year, will need a Licence to Occupy.
- Vehicles, structures, tents, marquees, or steel pegs are not allowed on turfed areas without specific approval from QLDC. Turf protection may also be required.
- There may be other permits or consent conditions depending on your event.
