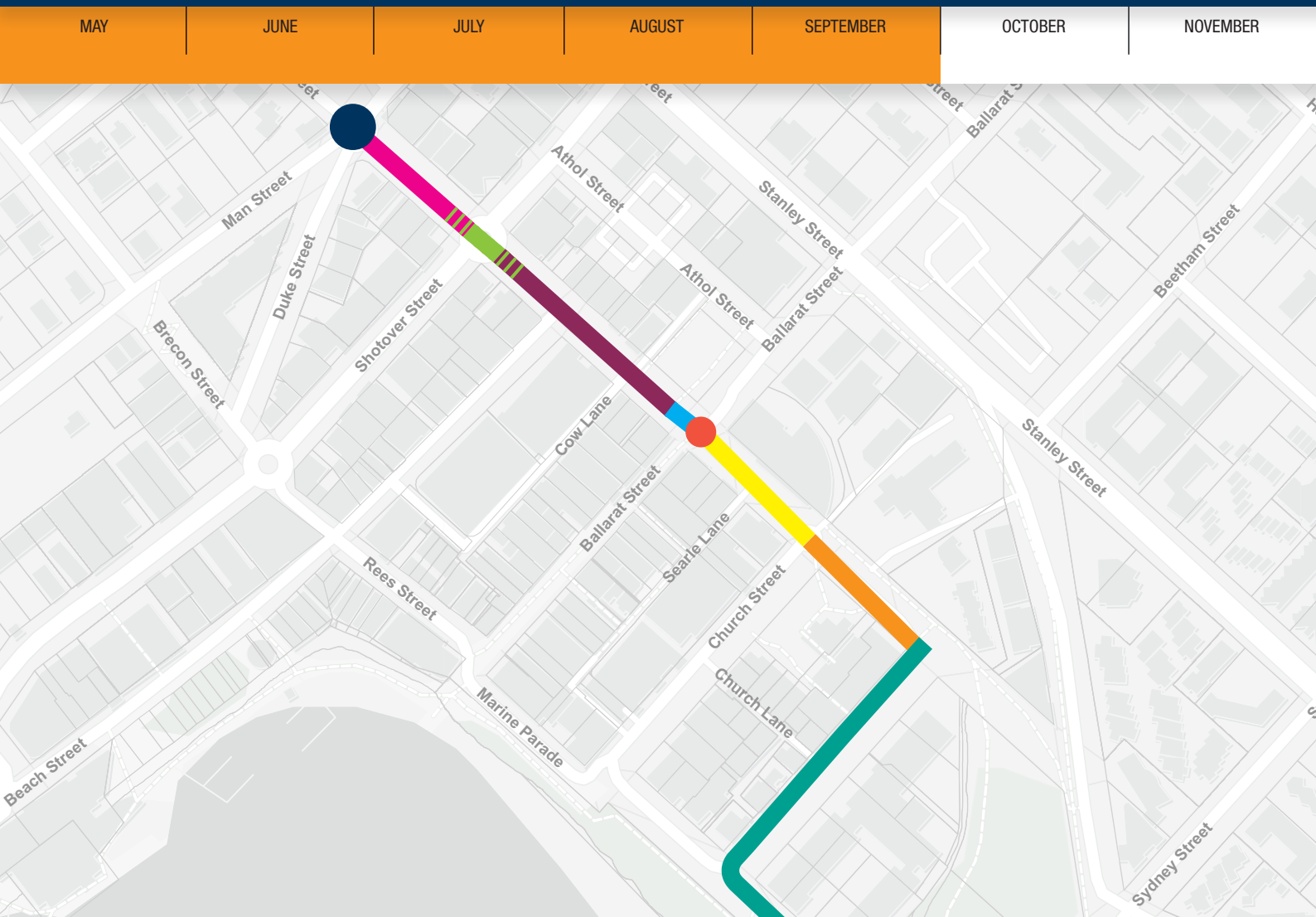


# RECREATION GROUND PUMP STATION AND WASTEWATER MAIN UPGRADE

The latest stage of work on the Recreation Ground Pump Station and Wastewater Upgrade project involves the construction of new wastewater pipeline along Camp Street in the Queenstown Town Centre. The wastewater pipe will be installed into open trenches and will result in a number of temporary road closures. The intention is to complete the work at the top of Camp Street ahead of the busy ski season. Thanks for your patience while this essential infrastructure upgrade is completed.



There will be a number of detours, loss of on-street parking and other disruptions in this area from 17 May until late September. Please allow extra time if you're driving into town or consider taking the bus. We'll keep you updated as the project progresses.

## CAMP STREET CLOSURES: 17 MAY – LATE SEPTEMBER 2021

-  Rec Ground Carpark to Camp Street Roundabout. Closed: 14 May for approx. 7 days.
-  Camp Street (between Memorial and Shotover) closed from 25 May for approx. 11 days
-  Shotover Street intersection. One lane closed from 10 June for approx. 7 days
-  Camp Street (between Shotover St and KFC drivethrough exit): closed from 21 June for approx. 8 days
-  Camp Street (between KFC drive through exit and Ballarat Street) closed from 1 July for approx. 2 days
-  Intersection closed from 5 July for approx. 5 days
-  Camp Street (between Ballarat and Church Street) one lane closed from 12 July for approx. 11 days
-  Camp Street (between Church and Earl St.) temporary removal of parking to allow lane shift. From 27 July for approx. 10 days
-  Earl Street to Marine Parade: temporary removal of parking to allow lane shift. From 10 August for approx. 17 days
