#### **Notice**

1. Clive Manners Wood ("**s274 Party**") wishes to be a party to the appeals by:

- (a) Andrew Fairfax ("Fairfax") v Queenstown Lakes District Council ("Council") ENV-2019-CHCH-00072 ("Fairfax Appeal"); and
- (b) Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association (NZ) Incorporated ("AOPA") v Queenstown Lakes District Council ("Council") ENV-2019-CHCH-00072 ("AOPA Appeal");

together, the "Appeals".

## Jurisdiction

- 2. The s274 Party made a submission on Stage 1 of the Queenstown Lakes District Proposed District Plan ("PDP") on or around 22 October 2015, and a further submission on 18 December 2015 ("original submissions"). The original submissions, and the s274 Party's subsequent appeal in respect of Stage 1 (ENV-2018-CHC-057-001) are deemed to be submissions and an appeal, respectively, against the relevant provisions of Stage 2 substituted by way of variation under Stage 2.
- 3. For completeness, the s274 Party also lodged an appeal against the Stage 2 decisions, *Clive Manners Wood v Queenstown Lakes District Council* ENV-2019-CHCH-00064 ("**Stage 2 Wood appeal**").
- 4. The original submissions and the Stage 2 Wood appeal raise matters that are the subject of the Appeals.

#### No trade competition

5. The s274 Party is not a trade competitor for the purpose of Section 308C or 308CA of the Act.

### Extent of interest in the proceedings

6. The s274 Party is interested in all of each of the Appeals.

7. The s274 Party is particularly interested in all the parts of the Appeals that relate to informal airports, including the policies, rules, standards and outcomes including in respect of amenity, character, and cumulative effects considerations arising from informal airports.

## Relief sought

- 8. The s274 Party generally opposes the relief sought in the Appeals, and particularly to the extent that the relief sought is inconsistent with the relief sought in the s274 Party's original submissions and the Stage 2 Wood Appeal.
- 9. The s274 Party seeks the relief sought in the s274 Party's original submissions and the Stage 2 Wood Appeal, for the reasons stated therein.

#### Mediation

10. The s274 Party agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the Appeals. Similar issues were resolved through mediation of the Stage 1 appeals.
