- 1. Counsel appeared for the Lismore Street group of submitters on Monday 25 August 2025, together with the group's planning expert, Mr Vivian.¹
- 2. During the presentation of the group submission, the Panel extended an offer for the group (via Mr Vivian), should it wish to do so, to explore the opportunity for a restricted discretionary (**RDIS**) rule framework in the event of a breach of the RL height rule promoted by the group.
- 3. While the group is appreciative of the offer and the time provided to consider an alternative default activity status for the rule, they remain of the view (supported by Mr Vivians expert evidence) that a fully discretionary activity status is appropriate and have therefore elected not to put forward a framework for a RDIS rule.
