RWC 2023 – Form 3 Notification To Cancel Extended Trading Hours



Licensee Notification To No Longer Extend Trading Hours during the 2023 Rugby World Cup

Under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Rugby World Cup 2023 Extended Trading Hours) Amendment Act 2023, eligible on-licensees and club licensees who had already notified of their intention to open outside their permitted trading hours to televise live Rugby World Cup 2023 games, <u>but</u> who have subsequently decided not to televise any games on specified nights, <u>must inform the relevant territorial authority and the constable at the nearest Police station of the changes:</u>
