Minor Corrections to Freedom Camping Bylaw 2025 | Ture ā-Rohe mō te Noho Puni Korehere 2025

Queenstown Lakes District Council advises of minor changes and corrections to the Freedom Camping Bylaw 2025 | Ture ā-Rohe mō te Noho Puni Korehere 2025 made pursuant to section 11B(4) of the Freedom Camping Act 2011.

These minor changes and corrections include:

- Cardrona Village: add prohibited urban area roads;
- Makarora: add prohibited urban area roads;
- Hāwea Flat: add restricted rural roads and prohibited areas;
- Arrowtown access road from Centennial Avenue to Arrow River Bridges Trail: add restricted rural road;
- Glendhu Bay, parcel between lake and reserve: add prohibited area;
- Victoria Flats Landfill: add prohibited area;
- Frankton, carparking area off Robertson Street: change to reserve status;

These were made by Council at the 5 February 2026 meeting and will be implemented from 12 February 2026.
