To address your request, we consulted the QLDC People and Capability Team who assisted in providing the following response:

Since 1 January 2022, QLDC has incurred annual subscription expenses of \$1,160 per year for Pride Pledge, covering the years 2023 and 2024. Please note that no subscription payment was made for 2022.

Additionally, we have invested \$2,185 in two staff training sessions scheduled in 2024. This amount includes costs for internal marketing materials, training resources, and other related expenses.

QLDC has not received any certifications through Pride Pledge.
