MY SUBMISSION

My submission is:

- 1. I generally support the identification of the Clutha River Corridor as an ONF.




Figure 1: Support the proposed revised location (within black circle) of the ONF boundary for Lot 3 DP 27742

- 2. I support the amendment of the Clutha ONF boundary as it applies to the property shown outlined in black in Figure 1 of Appendix A.




Figure 2: Oppose classification as ONF of properties outlined in black. Seek that these lots (Lot 1 and 2 DP 26282) are classified as RCL.

- 3. I oppose the classification of Lot 1 and 2 DP 26282 (Figure 2) as an ONL/ONF as it should be classified RCL as per original submission #531.
- 4. If these lots are not classified RCL I oppose the reclassification of Lot 1 and 2 DP 26282 from ONL to ONF as shown in Figure 2 of Appendix A.

Clearly state whether you SUPPORT or OPPOSE specific parts of the proposal.

Decision sought:

- 1. That the revised location of the Clutha ONF boundary is confirmed as shown in Figure 1.
- 2. That the Clutha ONF boundary is amended to exclude Lot 1 and 2 DP 26282 so that the lots are classified as RCL.
- 3. That if the lots 1 and 2 are not excluded from being classified as ONF/ONL then they remain classified as ONL not ONF.

Reasons for my submission:

The lots are cultivated paddocks as part of a working farm which extends to the adjacent land to the north. Having these lots classified as RCL better provides for consistent farm management and District Plan administration.

If Lots 1 and 2 remain as ONL, Policy 6.3.14 which currently acknowledges that working farms are within the districts ONLs applies. There is no such policy for ONFs which may complicate the future operations of the farm.
