Title | Taitara: Changes to the Operative and Proposed District Plans required to implement the National Environmental Standards for Commercial Forestry 2023

Purpose of the Report | Te Take mo te Puroko

The purpose of this report is to respond to Resolution 4 of Agenda Item 1 presented at the Planning & Strategy Committee ('the Committee) meeting held on 13 February 2024.

In this meeting, the Policy Planning team resolved to further investigate and report on the implications of giving effect to the National Environmental Standard for 2023 for Commercial Forestry (NES-CF) before amendments were made.

Specially, they would investigate whether amendments would create two definitions of 'Forestry' in the Operative District Plan (ODP) and Proposed District Plan (PDP) ('the district plans') that would make the district plans difficult to administer.

This report confirms the changes to the district plans that are needed to give effect to the NES-CF.

Recommendation | Kā Tūtohuka

That Planning & Strategy Committee:

- 1. Note the contents of this report;
- 2. Note the revised amendments to the Proposed District Plan and the Operative District Plan text (Attachment A) so that the district plans are consistent with the NES-CF;
- 3. Note the implications of these amendments for the district plans; and
- Approve the changes required to the district plans, pursuant to Section 44A of the Resource Management Act of 1991 (RMA), without using the process in RMA Schedule 1.

Context | Horopaki

Previous Planning & Strategy Committee minutes

- 1. In the 13 February 2024 Planning & Strategy Committee Meeting, the Policy Planning Team presented a summary of key changes to the district plans introduced by the NES-CF. They also presented an audit of the plan chapters that identified the changes to the plan text, required to give effect to the NES-CF.
- The Committee noted the contents of the report, that the NES came into force on the 3 November 2023 to amend the National Environmental Standards for Plantation Forestry 2017 (NES-PF), and that the changes are to be made as soon as is practicable, so that the district plans are consistent with the NES-CF.
- 3. There was further discussion on whether changing the NES definition of 'Plantation Forestry' to 'Commercial Forestry' would create two definitions of 'Forestry' in the district plans and would cause confusion for plan users.
- 4. The Policy Planning team resolved to investigate the implications of this update to the NES-PF, before changes are made to the district plan texts, and will do as the NES-CF requires.

Confirming the definition of 'forestry activity' in the PDP and ODP

5. A point of clarification from the committee was if there are any issues arising from differences in definitions that may affect District Plan implementation. The current and proposed amendments to the definition of 'Forestry Activity' are set out below. The definition and changes are the same in both versions of the district plan.

- 6. The district plan definition of 'Forestry Activity' currently includes the NES definition of 'Plantation Forestry', which was inserted to give effect to the NES-PF. This signals that 'Forestry Activity' means both the activities in scope of the NES-PF definition of 'forestry', as well as those caught by the district plan definition. Amending the definition to 'Commercial Forestry' updates the NES-CF definition and rule framework to this subset of forest or forestry activity, however the district plan definition continues to manage those forestry activities outside scope of the NES-CF, such as forestry that is not for commercial purposes, forestry occurring on land that is less than 1ha, or that is within urban areas.¹
- 7. The provision drafting convention established to implement the NES-PF is proposed to be retained, whereby, any references to 'Plantation Forestry' in the text will be amended to 'Commercial Forestry', including within the plan definition of 'Forestry Activity'. In addition, any references to the 'NES-PF' are updated to the 'NES-CF'. A renewed audit, in Attachment A, identifies where these provisions must be updated in the district plans.

Implications of these changes for plan users

- 8. Changing the NES-CF definition from 'Plantation' to 'Commercial Forestry' in the district plans simply means exotic continuous cover (carbon) forests are now managed under the NES-CF. It does not interfere with the plan definition of *Forestry Activity*, which continues to manage the effects of forestry activities where they are out of scope of the NES-CF.
- 9. District plan rules may remain more stringent than in the NES, if the standard provides for this.² Clause 6(2) of the NES-CF: *'matters of national importance'* allows council to set more stringent rules for managing forestry activities on outstanding natural landscapes ('ONL'), outstanding natural features ('ONF') or significant natural areas ('SNA'). These provisions will be retained.
- 10. Similarly, the NES-CF allows Councils to have more stringent or more lenient rules over the location of new carbon forests.³ This will mean that while the planting of wilding exotic trees, where in scope of the NES-CF, is now a permitted activity under the NES-CF⁴, it can remain a discretionary or prohibited activity under the district plans, and be managed by the 'Wakatipu Wilding Conifer Strategy.'
- 11. The NES-CF requires an applicant to notify both Regional and District Councils of the activity prior to commencement of the works. ⁵ This is a mandatory obligation, and it is at this stage that Council can assess the activity and check that it complies with the relevant permitted activities under the NES-CF, and that no district plan rules are triggered by the activity.
- 12. Where the activity does not comply with district plan standards and is not a permitted activity as set out under the NES-CF, it may require a resource consent under the district plan.

Analysis and Advice | Tatāritaka me kā Tohutohu

- 13. Council does not have any options in relation to this matter if Council aims to meet the requirements of the NPS-CF. Rules within district plans are required to have conflicts or duplications amended at the soonest practicable time. There is no impediment to Council making these changes now and therefore it is considered appropriate that the amendments are carried out pursuant to Section 44A, and as soon as is practicable.
- 14. The district plans currently have an 'except clause' to indicate that within 'Forestry Activities', 'Commercial Forestry' activities are governed by the NES-CF.⁶ To improve plan clarity, it is

recommended that an advice note be added to the district plan definition of 'Forestry Activity' to indicate when the NES-CF does and does not apply across the district plans. The advice note would read:

Advice note:

The NES-CF provisions apply to any 'Forestry Activity' that is within scope of the definition of 'Commercial Forestry' in NES-CF.

District plan provisions apply to any 'Forestry Activity' that is not within scope of the definition of 'Commercial Forestry' in the NES-CF.

Consultation Process | Hātepe Matapaki

Significance and Engagement | Te Whakamahi I kā Whakaaro Hiraka

- 15. This matter is of low significance, as determined by reference to the Council's Significance and Engagement Policy 2024. The ODP and PDP were updated in respect of the NES-PF in 2019, and are now required to be updated due to the amendments in the NES-CF.
- 16. The persons who are affected by or interested in this matter are the residents/ratepayers of the Queenstown Lakes district community. There will be limited effect on any person undertaking commercial forestry activities as the NES-CF is already in force, and the amendments to the district plans provide consistency with the NES-CF.
- 17. The Council is not required to implement the usual plan change process required by Schedule 1 of the RMA, and a public notice will be issued to draw attention to the changes to the ODP and PDP.

Māori Consultation | Iwi Rūnaka

18. No consultation will be undertaken with Rūnaka on this matter, as this is not required under section 44A(5)(a) RMA. In developing the NES-CF, Central government conducted their own process of calling for submissions and holding a select committee, and the NES-CF provides a national direction that Council is obliged to observe.

Risk and Mitigations | Kā Raru Tūpono me kā Whakamaurutaka

- 19. This matter relates to the Community & Wellbeing risk category. It is associated with RISK10034 Inadequate resource management or building consent systems, processes and/or people capability results in poor development outcomes and liability within the QLDC Risk Register. This risk has been assessed as having a moderate residual risk rating.
- 20. The approval of the recommended option will support the Council by allowing us to retain the risk at its current level. This shall be achieved by amending the district plans to meet Council's statutory requirements in respect of NES's.



Financial Implications | Kā Riteka ā-Pūtea

21. There are no financial implications for this recommendation.

Council Effects and Views | Kā Whakaaweawe me kā Tirohaka a te Kaunihera

22. The following Council policies, strategies and bylaws were considered:

• QLDC Operative and Proposed District Plans.

Legal Considerations and Statutory Responsibilities | Ka Ture Whaiwhakaaro me kā Takohaka Waeture

- 23. The NES-CF came into force on 3 November 2023 and district plans are required to be updated as soon as practicable.⁷
- 24. Section 44A of the RMA requires that rules in district plans do not duplicate or conflict with an NES. Provision is made under s44A(5)(a) for a local authority to amend district plans without using Schedule 1 of the RMA.

Local Government Act 2002 Purpose Provisions | Te Whakatureture 2002 o te Kāwanataka ā-Kīaka

25. The recommended option:

- The NES-CF sets out a national direction that the Council is required to implement. The
 amendments to the ODP and PDP will ensure that environmental standards set by the NESCF are implemented through the district plans. As such, the recommendation in this report
 is appropriate and within the ambit of Section 10 of the Act, which states the purpose of local
 government is (a) to enable democratic local decision-making and action by, and on behalf
 of, communities; and (b) to promote the social, economic, environmental, and cultural wellbeing of communities in the present and for the future.
- Can be implemented through current funding under the Long-Term Plan and Annual Plan;
- Is consistent with the Council's plans and policies; and
- Would not significantly alter the intended level of service provision for any significant activity undertaken by or on behalf of the Council or transfer the ownership or control of a strategic asset to or from the Council.

Regulation 6 of the NES-CF allows for more stringent rules if relates to matters of national importance and <u>the rule recognises and provides for the protection</u> of –

- (a) Outstanding natural features and landscapes from inappropriate use and development; or
- (b) Significant natural areas

No changes are proposed to insert new rules or amend existing provisions to be more stringent in relation to either matter. Key
